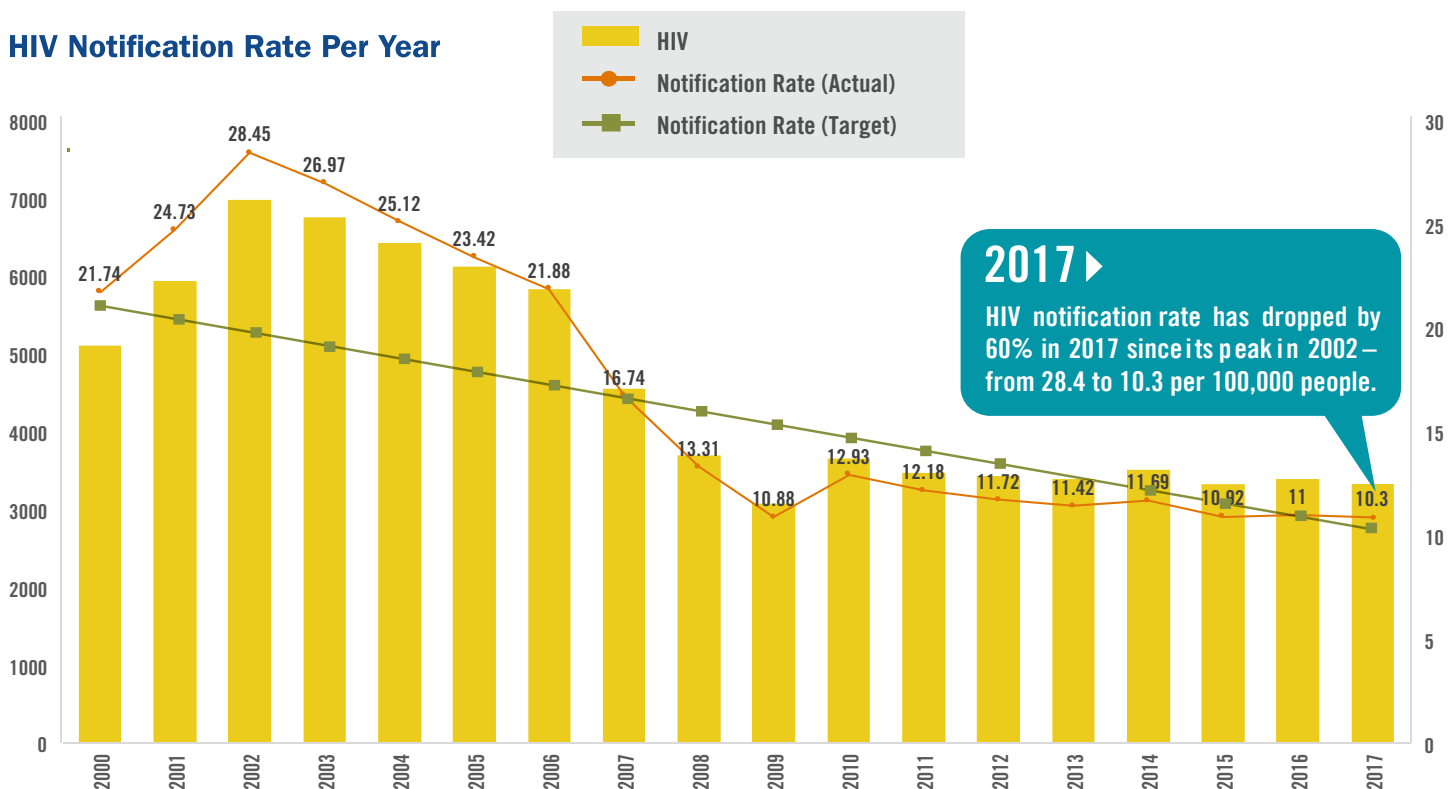

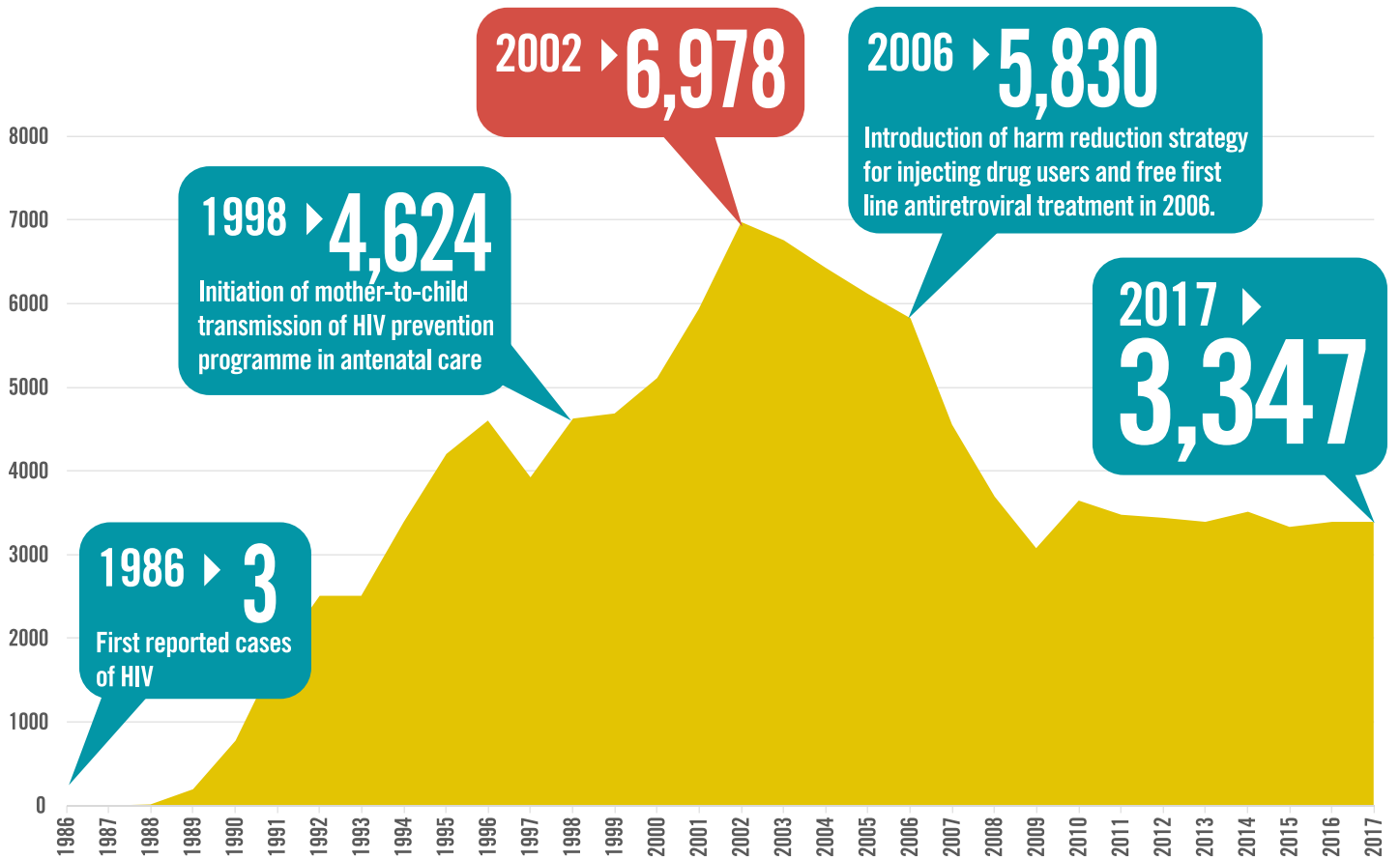
Overview of the HIV & AIDS Epidemic in Malaysia

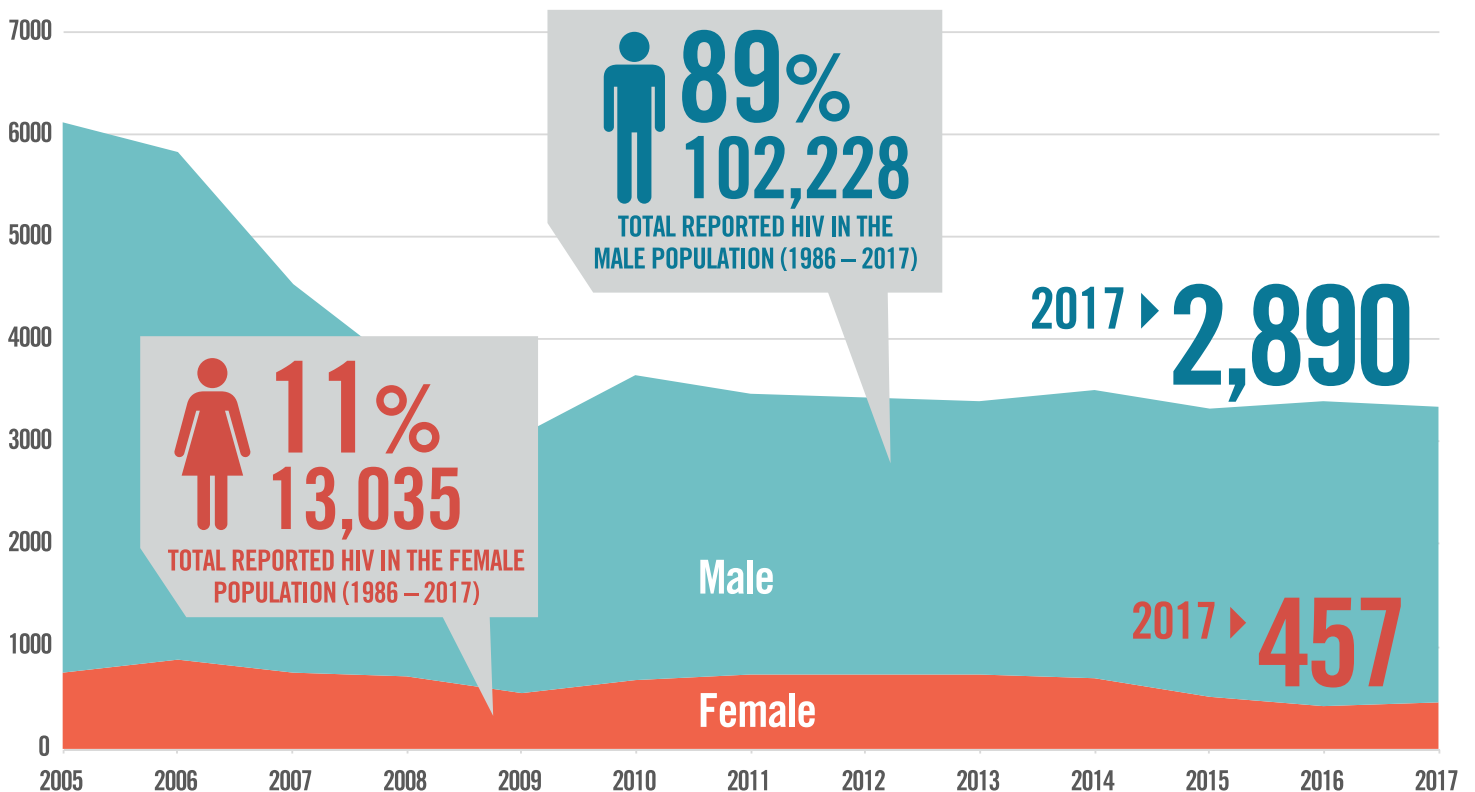
HIV Notification Rate Per Year



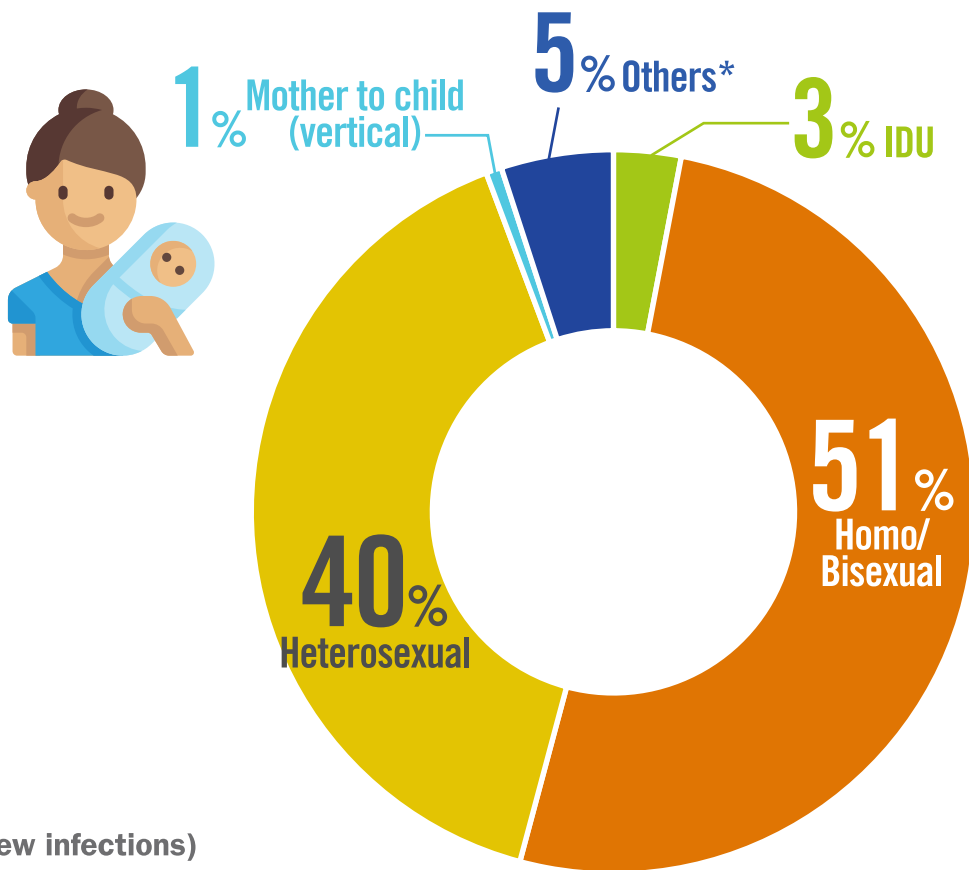
New HIV Cases (1986-2017)



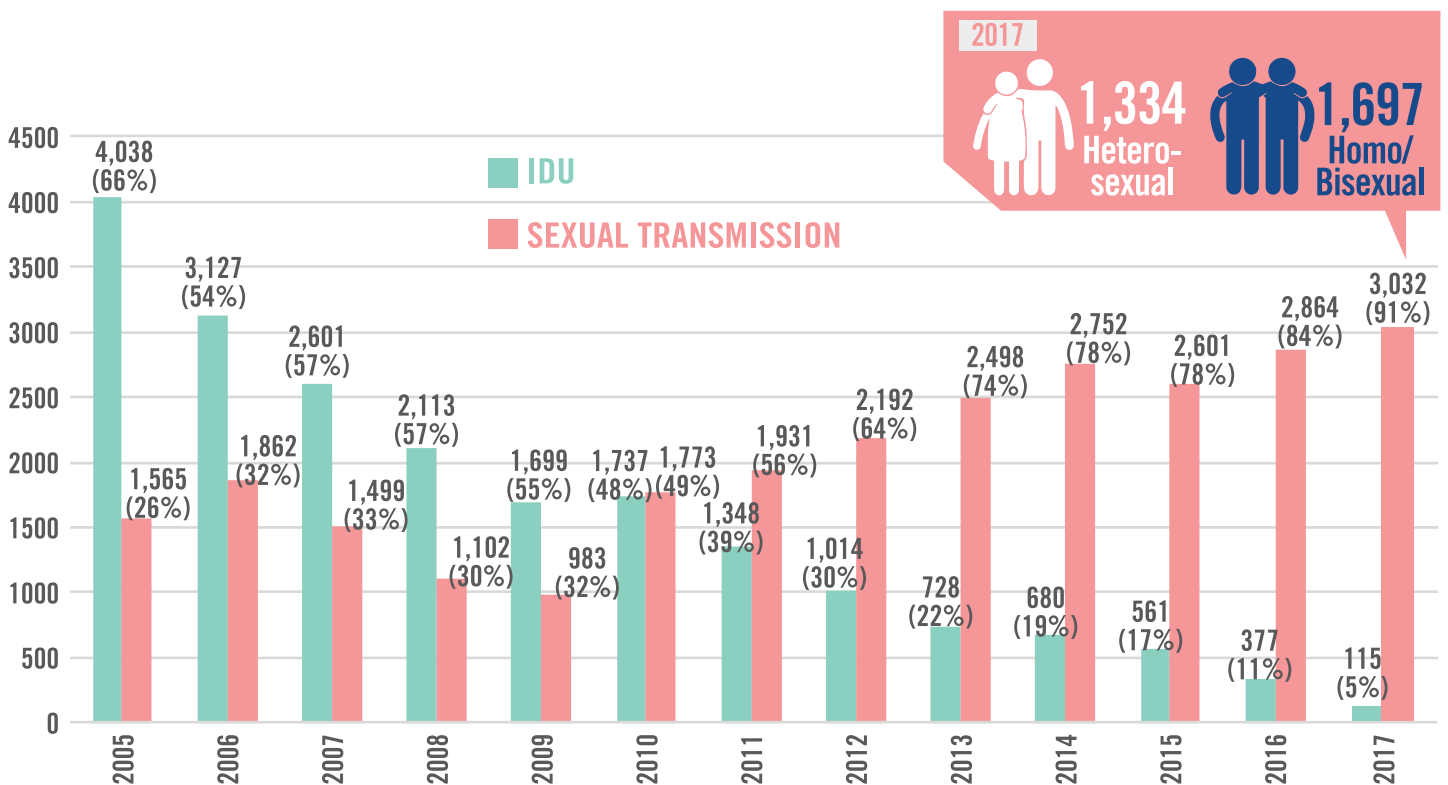
HIV Transmission by Sex (2005 – 2017)



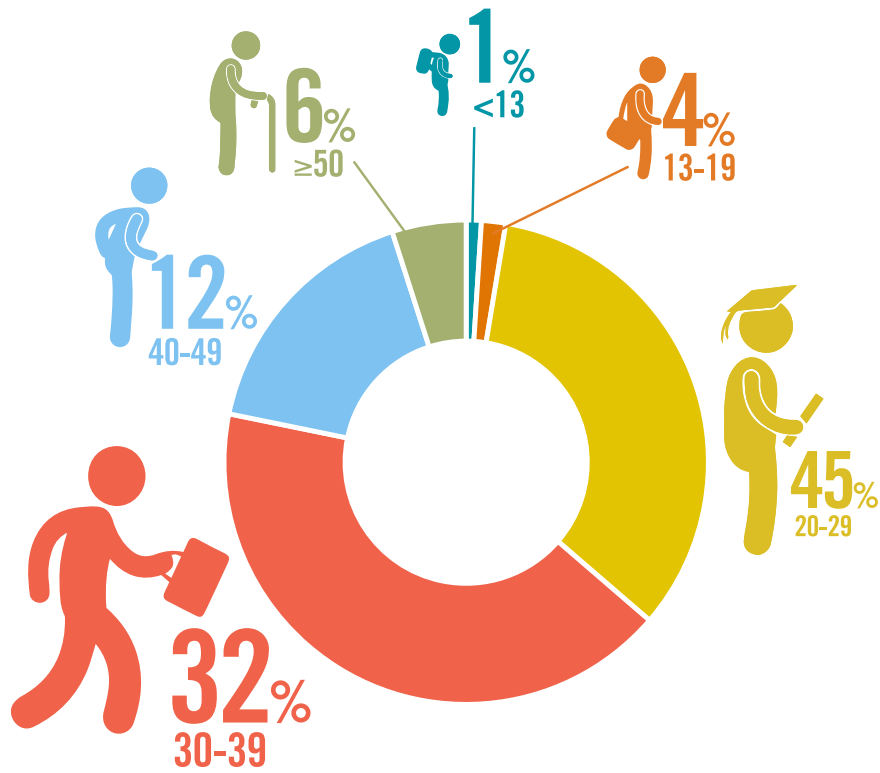
HIV Transmission by Risk Factor in 2017



Comparison of New HIV Infections between Injecting Drug Use and Sexual Transmission (2005 – 2017)

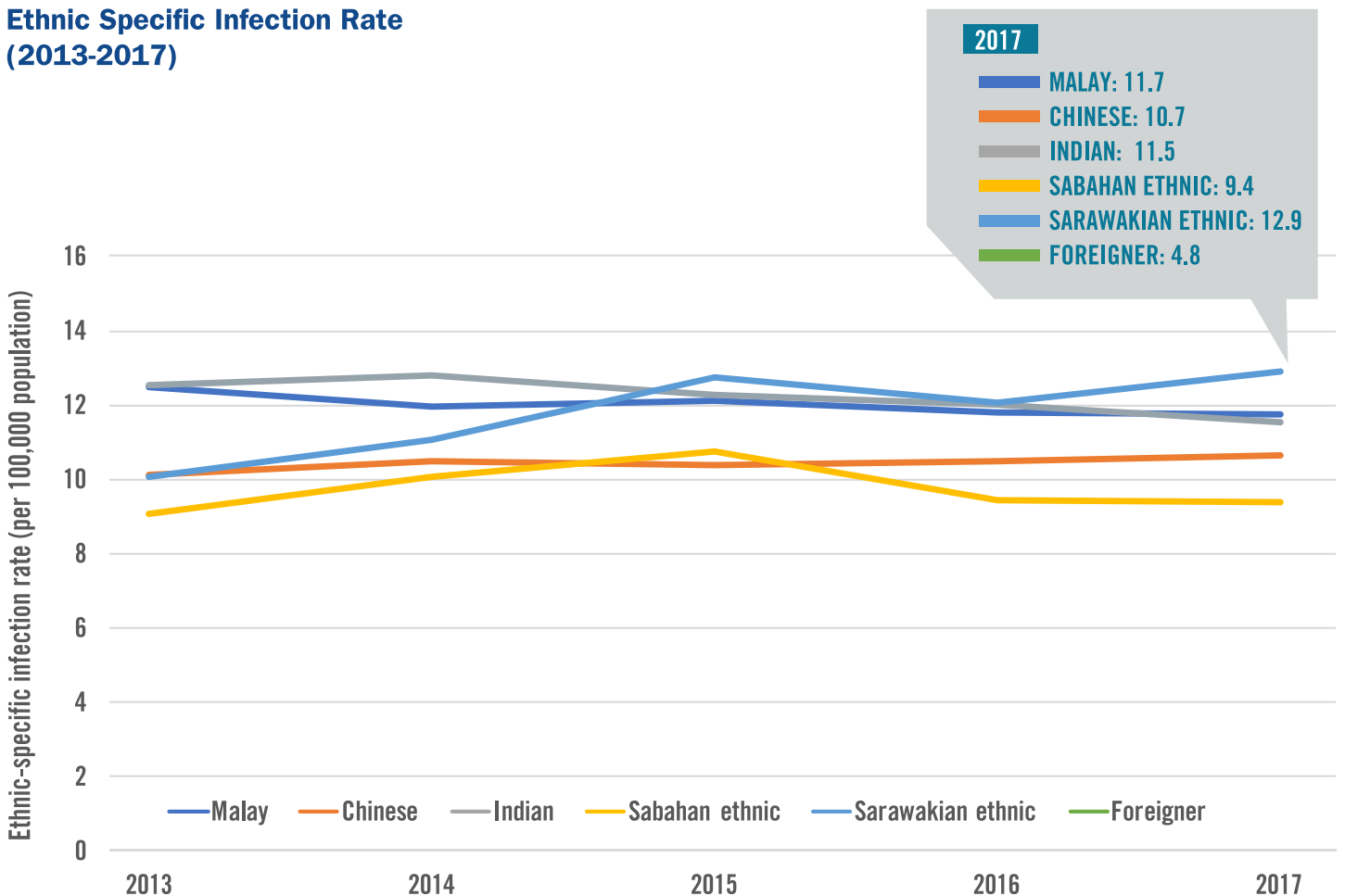


HIV Transmission by Age Group in 2017
